Lubricant Ophthalmic solution with CMC 0.5%

1. What HYDRAdrop® is and what it is used for

This product is a preservative-free, sterile ophthalmic solution containing carmellose sodium 0.5%.

HYDRAdrop® is used for symptoms of ocular dryness. This lubricant ophthalmic solution has wetting and protective properties which provide relief to the eye in case of irritation, burning and foreign body sensation due to a reduction in the tear film.

The tear film weakness results from environmental factors such as wind, sun, dry air, salt water, smoke, intense light conditions, prolonged use of the computer, or in case of ophthalmic surgery, conjunctivitis or frequent and prolonged use of contact lenses. This product is not normally intended for use for more than 30 days; if the symptoms persist consult your doctor.

2. What you need to know before you use HYDRAdrop®

Precautions and warnings

- do not use if the container is damaged
- do not use if you are sensitive to any of the components of the product
- do not use after the expiry date shown on the carton and container
- do not touch the eye with the tip of the container
- Leave at least 10-15 minutes between administration of any other ophthalmic drugs;
- do not swallow;
- The product is only for ophthalmic use;

- If you wear soft contact lenses, remove them before applying product and do not replace the lenses for at least 15 minutes.

3. How to use HYDRAdrop®

1 drop in the eyes 2-3 times daily.

4. Possible side effects

After administration in rare cases a slight temporary blurring of vision may be observed due to the viscosity of the solution. It is therefore advisable to wait for a few seconds before any activity that requires clear vision.

Slight irritation of the eye, stinging and redness may occasionally occur during the use. In most cases this disappears after a few minutes.

5. How to store HYDRAdrop®

Store between 2°C and 25°C;

Discard the bottle 4 weeks after first opening;

Keep out of the reach and sight of children.

6. Contents of the pack and other information

HYDRAdrop®: Lubricant ophthalmic solution; 10 ml bottle.

Composition: Carmellose sodium, lactic acid, sodium hydroxide, sodium chloride, potassium chloride, calcium chloride, sodium edetate, cetrimide, water.
